4. Maintain a well-managed classroom and positive learning environment
5. Supervise students out of class such as in the hallways and in the cafeteria
6. Depending on needs, may be assigned to non-substitute teaching duties, such as proctoring, administration, operations and other functions to help Berean operate optimally
7. Other duties as assigned
